



PARKING

Thank you, parents, for your support as we strive to improve the parking procedures on campus. In recent weeks there were several concerns expressed about drivers who were not following procedures and thus we have stepped up efforts to monitor the parking area during drop-off and pick-up times. All of these efforts are to ensure safety for all at CIS. Perhaps you have noticed:

- There is an additional security guard to assist with parking procedures at drop-off and dismissal time. This guard will continue at CIS for a few more weeks.
- The security guards are easily identified by the bright orange and yellow safety vests.
- The drop-off zone in front of the school has been running much more smoothly with parents leaving (and thus freeing up the parking stall) as soon as their child is safely on the sidewalk. The same zone is reserved for pick-up only at the end of the day, and parents must stay in the cars and depart ASAP in order to free up the parking spaces.
- We continue to insist that all drivers safely pull into a parking stall before allowing a child to exit or enter a car. We do not allow a child to enter or exit a car unless the driver has pulled into a parking stall.

We have heard many positive comments about how the parking works much more smoothly when everyone works together to follow the procedures.



IB INFORMATION NIGHT

course at CIS? Come join Ms. Sarah and Dr. Jeremy at an IB information session on Thursday, March 21st at 6:00 in the MPR. This session is open to the public and all who seek to learn about the International Baccalaureate.



March 22nd (next Friday) is the 20th annual International World Water Day, which has been organised by the UN since 1993.

Conservative estimations show that 2.5 billion people in the world (over 1 in 3) don't have access to adequate sanitation, and over 758 million people (1 in 10) don't even have access to safe, clean, drinking water.

In an effort to help combat some of these problems, our 11th Grade IB Diploma students are going to be fundraising to purchase Life Straws for Haiti. With the help of the Fort Lauderdale Rotary Club, who already send aid shipments to Haiti, our CAS students (Community, Action and Service, a mandatory component of the IB Diploma) will be raising money to provide straws which filter water as you are drinking it, meaning that everyone with access to a water supply, has access to clean, safe, drinking water. This can help to save millions of lives each year, and we wish our 11th Grade the best of luck in their efforts to support our neighbouring countries. Look out for upcoming opportunities where you can help them achieve their fundraising goals!




