The School: CIS is a co-educational, college preparatory day school governed by international school services. CIS was founded as Faulkner Academy in 1994. Today it is housed in a new, purpose built 60,000 square foot facility on 13.2 acres that opened in the fall of 2006. In addition to the United States High School Diploma, students can earn the International Baccalaureate Diploma.

Governance: CIS is governed by International School Services (ISS), a nonprofit corporation dedicated to excellence for children attending overseas schools worldwide.

Accreditations & Affiliations: CIS is accredited by the Middle States Association and is an IB World School offering the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. The school is a member of the Association of the American Schools in South America (ASSA), the Common Ground Collaborative, Round Square, and Green Alliance Schools.

Student Body: There are approximately 650 students enrolled in the whole school (Early Childhood to Grade 12), 118 in the high school, and 18 in the senior class. Students represent 40 nationalities and the majority of students are dual passport holders. Approximately 25% of the student body is Caymanian. Class sizes are kept small in order to allow for personalized learning and to encourage students to grow and develop to their fullest potential.

Faculty: There are 118 full-time staff members and 6 full-time administrators at CIS. The staff consists of 54 U.S Citizens, 22 Canadian citizens, 14 Caymanians, 4 British citizens, 5 Jamaican citizens, and expatriates from 16 various additional countries. The faculty to student ratio is 9:1.

Extra-Curricular Activities: CIS students participate in a wide variety of extra-curricular activities. CIS athletes participate in Caribbean Area International School Sports Association (CAISSA) and Private Schools Association (PSA) and compete in football, volleyball, basketball, track and field, and swimming. Students also compete in debate, Model United Nations, and robotics. Other extra-curricular activities include National Honors Society, High School Leadership, Musical Theatre, Steel Pan Band, Jazz Band, and Rock Band.

Service & Internships: Students provide leadership in community service initiatives and/or internships outside school boundaries. These activities may include visits to children recovering from heart surgery, the collection and distribution of school and personal supplies to needy local children, service trips to Peru, Honduras, Haiti, and Nicaragua, peer tutoring in local schools, and leadership in sports programs across the island.

Calendar: There are 182 days in the school year which are divided into four terms. The 1st term starts in August and the 4th term ends in June.
