Overview Fall 2018

U13 Boys Football

Our U13 Boys compete in the Dart U13 Football League. Additionally, we will participate in the KPMG Football Fest tournament in Nassau, November 1-4. Due to the competitive nature of this league and the high level of participation at this level, it is possible that some players who tryout for this team will not be asked to train with the squad for the season.

U14 Girls Football

Our U14 Girls are the reigning champions of the Dart U14 Girls Football League. As well, our U13 Girls Football team returned from the KPMG Football Fest tournament in Nassau as champions. We plan to repeat both of those feats again in 2018. For the same reasons listed above, there is the possibility that some girls who tryout will not be able to train with the squad.

U18 Boys Football

Our U18 Boys will compete in the Private Schools Association (PSA) U18 Boys Football League. As well, we will send a select squad to CAISSA Season 2 in Port St. Lucie, Florida in late January. Coach Sam looks to build upon the positives of the last two seasons.

U18 Girls Football

Our primary objective is to prepare our U18 Girls for the CAISSA Season 2 Tournament in Port St. Lucie, Florida. We hope to participate in a revamped PSA Girls Football League though that will depend heavily on the participation of our peer schools. Our girls are two time runners up in the CAISSA Girls Football Tournament.

Tryouts Fall 2018

Tryout Dates and Times:

- o ALL TEAMS: Monday, August 27; Thursday, August 30; Friday, August 31
- Players must arrive at the pitch NO LATER than 3:30pm. All tryout sessions will last until 5:00pm.
- All players must attend ALL tryout sessions to be considered for the squad. If a player
 is injured, sick, or otherwise unable to attend, the coach(es) for that team must be
 contacted at least 24 hours ahead of time and a legitimate excuse provided. Final
 discretion regarding attendance rests with the Athletic Director and administrators.
- All players must come to tryout sessions fully prepared. This means appropriate
 football attire (athletic shirt, shorts, football socks, **shin pads**, and football boots).
 Additionally, players should plan to bring water bottles and sun protection. CIS will
 provide cold water but players are expected to bring their own water bottles.
- Selection Criteria: Final decision for selection is the prerogative of each team's coach. That being said, the CIS Football coaching team, including Athletic Director, have established a common language and set of expectations that we hope to see in all of our athletes. Coaches will share feedback throughout the tryout process to ensure that fair and developmentally appropriate decisions are made. Selection criteria can best be summarized in the following way:
