For example, our current grade eight class has a RIT score of 234 which means the average student in that grade is at the 81<sup>st</sup> percentile. In grade 7 the average RIT score for that class was a 230, grade 6 the average RIT score was a 228, grade 5 the average RIT score was a 224 and grade 4 the average RIT score was a 216. Because each cohort is different we look at the grade levels as they move each year. Additionally, CIS looks at the scores at each grade to ensure the RIT scores are not changing drastically and our curriculum is maintained.
